

Headlands Center for the Arts is just fifteen minutes away from San Francisco, but feels like another world. The Marin Headlands is where the land meets the sea, and home to Headlands Center for the Arts—a unique and memorable venue for weddings, corporate retreats, celebrations, and special events.

RENTAL BASICS

- Every space rental includes a one-year complimentary membership for two members.
- Non-profit discount of 10% is available with documentation (not applicable for weddings).
- Weekday rental hours: 9AM-5PM or 10AM-6PM, additional hours available with hourly charge.
- Weekend rental hours: Twelve hour space use, additional hours available with hourly charge.
- Groups larger than 50 must rent the full building. Per Room rentals are not available on weekends.
- All space rentals include a welcome and introduction to Headlands from a staff member, access to Headlands' wifi upon request.
- Please note: There is no cell service or public transporation available in the Marin headlands. All
 restrooms and Headlands are unisex. Due to the historic nature of our building, an elevator is not
 available.

WEEKDAY Per Room

\$2,500

Includes use of one artistrenovated room: Eastwing, Westwing, or Rodeo Room.

WEEKDAY Full Building

\$8,500

\$12,500

Includes use of two floors of Headlands' artist-renovated spaces: Mess Hall, Eastwing, Westwing, and Rodeo Room.



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AVAILABLE ADD-ONS

- Hourly rates listed above.

- For multi-day rentals: Cleaning available for a \$1,000 fee.
- AV, Coffee/tea, and outdoor heaters are available for additional \$200 (respectively).
- Mess Hall dining is available for groups of 15 or less for a \$200 fee.

HEADLANDS' SPACES

Rodeo Room

Renovated in 1987 by conceptual sculptors David Ireland and Mark Thompson, the Rodeo Room often functions as Headlands' conference room. The walls are shellacked with rich colors of ochre and green, reflecting the hues in the hills visible just beyond the windows. Max occupancy: 22. Room Measurements: Square footage: 612; 36' L x 17' W x 12'



Eastwing

The Eastwing is the main public event space in Building 944. Like the Rodeo Room, the space was remade by David Ireland, who led its renovation in 1987 with an eye towards creating an aesthetically pleasing and functional space. Occupancy varies by event. Room Measurements: Square footage: 1,850, 50' L x 37' W x 12' H.




Mess Hall

The Mess Hall, Headlands' dining space, is much more than a utilitarian renovation. Artist Ann Hamilton created a comfortable and welcoming environment that encourages interaction among all who come to Headlands. From the mismatched chairs, to the hearth-flanked open space for preparing and eating food, the Mess Hall embodies the sense of community that is so integral to Headlands' mission. Seated capacity: 140. Room Measurements: 39'10" x 34'.

Westwing

The Westwing, also known as the Officer's Club, is a large space that is home to an eclectic mix of items, including an array of tables, chairs, and couches. This room is a popular choice for groups looking to spread out and move around, or those who desire a less traditional meeting space. Occupancy varies by event. Room Measurements: 50' L x 37' W x 12' H; Square footage: 1,850.
